NATURAL BURIAL OPTIONS

Lower Meadow

The Restoration of Fernwood's Coastal Prairie.

Habitat Interpretation: High density of wild flowers provides a seed bank for surrounding lands and habitat for butterflies. On-going eradication of broom and other invasive species. Graves are nestled into a hillside with views of Mount Tamalpais with hiking trails into the Ancestral Forest.

Upper Meadow

The Restoration of Fernwood's Coastal Prairie.

Graves are nestled into a hillside with views down Tennessee Valley with hiking trails into Founders' Forest and Golden Gate National Recreation Area.

Founders' Forest

Habitat Interpretation: Founders' Forest represents the ongoing restoration of an Oak woodland with Heritage Eucalyptus Trees planted by 19th Century Dairy farmers marking their herding trails.

Ancestral Forest

These spaces exist in this tranquil wooded area of Fernwood. A meandering trail makes its way through the trees starting from the pioneer section heading towards the Golden Gate National Recreation Area.

Golden Gate

Cremation spaces only exist on this hillside meadow at Fernwood. A rustic trail leads from Upper Meadow to Golden Gate. *Note: Not easily accessible.*

Founders Transition

This easily accessible area defines the boundary between the historic cemetery and the natural burial areas. These hillsides are being restored to natural grasslands with scattered Oak and Bay trees mixed with the historic Eucalyptus trees planted by 19th century farmers. Founders Transition features sweeping views of Tennessee Valley and Mt. Tamalpais.

Sacred Grove

Dotted with Oaks, Acacia, and Redwoods, this premier and accessible location rests on a grassy knoll with stunning 360 views of Mt. Tamalpais, Mill Valley, Tam Valley, and Golden Gate National Recreation Area.

Gan Yarok

Gan Yarok is a natural burial Jewish cemetery within Fernwood and located on a hillside meadow reached by a meandering trail through the Ancestral Forest. Orthodox, Conservative and Community sections within Gan Yarok each carry specific burial rules and regulations.

Gan Yarok Expansion

Due to the popularity of Gan Yarok, adjacent land was annexed in 2018. Gan Yarok Expansion features a gently sloped stone bordered pathway meandering through a forest of native Coast Live Oaks and Bay trees. The pathway breaks at two points into circular gathering areas for services and quiet visitation.

Scattering Options

Scattering includes attendance by up to 6 guests and service up to 20 minutes. Larger groups and/or longer services will incur graveside service charge of \$400. Scattering can be scheduled Monday through Saturday during normal business hours.

Scattering Areas are communal areas for cremated remains only and do not allow for individual markers.

Outsized/Exceptionally-Sized Burial and Interment Fees

People come in all shapes and sizes. If an individual's weight and/or height require burial spaces larger than 8ft by 3ft, an additional purchase of spaces may be required. In some circumstance, 1/2 grave space may be added to an existing grave. In most instances, the purchase of an additional grave will be necessary. In addition, in these circumstances, an additional 50% will be charged to the applicable interment service fee.

Memorials in our Natural Burial areas must conform to our ecological and aesthetic guidelines.

Traditional Monuments and Memorials

We carry a wide range of monuments and memorial markers in both granite and bronze. Prices are based on size, shape, and material. Installation fees are additional and are also based on size, shape, and material.

Outer Burial Containers

Traditionally, the purpose of an outer burial container is to protect the casket from the weight of the earth above and to prevent the entrance of outside elements. Outer Burial Containers—or “vaults”—are not required by law, but cemeteries may require them if they so desire.

At Fernwood, we may require an outer burial container in the traditional sections of the cemetery, but only when it is absolutely necessary for health, safety, or ecological reasons. Installation fees are additional and are based on type of vault and material. Outer Burial Containers are not permitted in the natural burial sections.
